The pointer will not be released if *time* is earlier than the last-pointer-grab time or later than the current X server time.

#### DESCRIPTION

Releases the pointer and any queued events if you actively grabbed the pointer before using  $xcb\_grab\_pointer$ ,  $xcb\_grab\_button$  or within a normal button press.

EnterNotify and LeaveNotify events are generated.

## **RETURN VALUE**

Returns an xcb\_void\_cookie\_t. Errors (if any) have to be handled in the event loop.

If you want to handle errors directly with *xcb\_request\_check* instead, use *xcb\_ungrab\_pointer\_checked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.

## **ERRORS**

This request does never generate any errors.
