DESCRIPTION

Unmaps the specified window. This means making the window invisible (and all its child windows).

Unmapping a window leads to the *UnmapNotify* event being generated. Also, *Expose* events are generated for formerly obscured windows.

RETURN VALUE

Returns an xcb_void_cookie_t. Errors (if any) have to be handled in the event loop.

If you want to handle errors directly with *xcb_request_check* instead, use *xcb_unmap_window_checked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.

ERRORS

xcb_window_error_t

The specified window does not exist.
