REQUEST ARGUMENTS

conn The XCB connection to X11.

REPLY FIELDS

- response_type* The type of this reply, in this case *XCB_X_PRINT_PRINT_GET_ATTRIBUTES*. This field is also present in the *xcb_generic_reply_t* and can be used to tell replies apart from each other.
- sequence* The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.
- length* The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).
- stringLen* TODO: NOT YET DOCUMENTED.

DESCRIPTION**RETURN VALUE**

Returns an *xcb_x_print_print_get_attributes_cookie_t*. Errors have to be handled when calling the reply function *xcb_x_print_print_get_attributes_reply*.

If you want to handle errors in the event loop instead, use *xcb_x_print_print_get_attributes_unchecked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.
