**REQUEST ARGUMENTS**

*conn* The XCB connection to X11.

**REPLY FIELDS**

*response\_type* The type of this reply, in this case *XCB\_XF86DRI\_QUERY\_VERSION*. This field is also present in the *xcb\_generic\_reply\_t* and can be used to tell replies apart from each other.

*sequence* The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

*length* The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).
