NAME

`xcb_xfixes_set_client_disconnect_mode` - Sets the disconnect mode for the client.

SYNOPSIS

#include <xcb/xfixes.h>
```

xcb_void_cookie_t xcb_xfixes_set_client_disconnect_mode(xcb_connection_t *conn,  
uint32_t disconnect_mode);
```

REQUEST ARGUMENTS

conn The XCB connection to X11.

disconnect_mode
 The new disconnect mode.

DESCRIPTION

RETURN VALUE

Returns an *xcb_void_cookie_t*. Errors (if any) have to be handled in the event loop.

If you want to handle errors directly with *xcb_request_check* instead, use *xcb_xfixes_set_client_disconnect_mode_checked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.

ERRORS

This request does never generate any errors.
