xml2-config - script to get information about the installed version of libxml2

SYNOPSIS

xml2-config [--prefix[=*DIR*]] [--libs] [--cflags] [--version] [--help]

DESCRIPTION

xml2-config is a tool that is used to determine the compile and linker flags that should be used to compile and link programs that use *libxml2*.

OPTIONS

xml2-config accepts the following options:

--version Print the currently installed version of *libxml2* on the standard output.

--libs Print the linker flags that are necessary to link a *libxml2* program. Add `--dynamic` after `--libs` to print only shared library linking information.

--cflags Print the compiler flags that are necessary to compile a *libxml2* program.

--prefix=PREFIX

If specified, use PREFIX instead of the installation prefix that *libxml2* was built with when computing the output for the `--cflags` and `--libs` options. This option must be specified before any `--libs` or `--cflags` options.
