

NAME

yppoll - ask version of NIS map from NIS server

SYNOPSIS

yppoll [-d *domain*] [-h *host*] *mapname*

DESCRIPTION

yppoll asks a NIS server process for the order number and which host is the master server for *mapname*.

The options are as follows:

-d *domain*

Use the NIS domain *domain* instead of the default domain as returned by `domainname(1)`.

-h *host* Ask the NIS server process running on *host* for information about *mapname*. If *host* is not specified, the server polled is the default server returned by `ypwhich(1)`.
