**zip\_error\_init**, **zip\_error\_init\_with\_code** - initialize zip\_error structure

**SYNOPSIS**

**DESCRIPTION**

The **zip\_error\_init()** function initializes the `zip_error` pointed to by `error`. `*error` must be allocated before calling **zip\_error\_init()**.

The **zip\_error\_init\_with\_code()** function does the same, but additionally sets the zip error code to `ze` and sets the system error code to the current `errno(3)` value, if appropriate.
